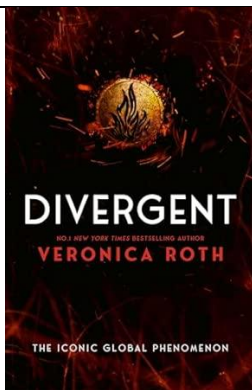


COMING UP!

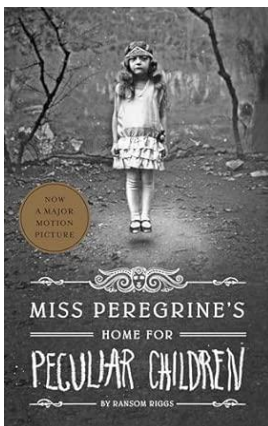


COMING UP!
